Montreal ToyCon Terms & Conditions

1) TABLE SPACE

Exhibitor agrees to remain set up during all open hours of the convention. No early breakdown is allowed without the prior consent of the ToyCon.

Electrical, telephone, and internet services are extra and can be provided by the stadium for an additional charge. Please inquire if needed.

Exhibitor agrees to keep their areas clean and is responsible for any damage.

2) DISPLAY & FIRE REGULATIONS

Booths & Displays

Do not encroach on aisles that border your booth. Fire Extinguishers, Hose Cabinets, Fire Exits or Fire Alarms can not be blocked or covered.

Games of chance: No exhibitor shall participate, offer or conduct games of chance from his booth (ie.dices, lotteries, lucky draws, etc.)

No smoking permitted within the Hotel.

Noise & Damages

Exhibitors must police their own tables to be sure that noise levels from sound systems is kept to a minimum and does not interfere with others. ToyCon reserves the right to determine at what point sound constitutes interference with others and must be discontinued.

Any Damage caused to the building or furnishings by the Exhibitor is the sole responsibility of the Exhibitor.

3) SETUP

Setup will begin at 7am and move-out will be after 5pm. Dealers cannot pack up and leave early.

4) PAYMENT FOR SPACE & SUBLETTING

Exhibitor understands the payment policy and agrees to pay the fees as listed on the Exhibitor Request Form.

Subletting of table space or sharing of table space is not allowed without the express permission of ToyCon.

In the case of more than one exhibitor sharing one table, the person whose name appears on this contract assumes full responsibility for that table, as specified here. ToyCon must be notified, at the time of table reservation, of exhibitors intending to share space.

5) Cancellations & Refunds

Should the exhibitor decide to withdraw his participation the show management shall retain as a cancellation fee all monies paid. However, in the interest of harmonious relationship, the management shall attempt to replace the exhibitor and refund his money less any costs incurred.

6) ADULT MERCHANDISE FOR SALE

Exhibitor agrees not to sell or distribute any adult material to minors. All Adults Only material must be either behind the table or, if displayed on a table or display rack, bagged or covered so that minors may not open it. Any adult material depicting nudity must be "blinded" (i.e. the nudity or sexual conduct must be covered). Adult videos and magazines are not to be displayed openly. They must be kept behind the tables. A sign may be posted to let customers know that you carry that merchandise.

7) SALES TAX

Exhibitors are responsible for collection and payment of retail sales taxes (GST and QST) .

8) LIABILITY & SECURITY

ToyCon are not responsible for any theft or loss. Exhibitor is responsible for his or her own security during show hours.

The Exhibitor agrees to protect, keep, and save ToyCon., the promoter of the event, forever harmless from any damage(s) or charge(s) imposed for violations of any ordinance or regulation by the Exhibitor, his employees or agents, as well as failure to comply with the terms and agreements of this contract. Further, Exhibitors shall at all times protect, indemnify, save, and keep harmless ToyCon. against and from any loss, cost, damage, liability, or expense which arises out of or from or by reason of any act or omission of the Exhibitor, his employees, or agents.

In the event that the exhibit area thereof is unavailable, whether for the entire event or a portion of the event, as a result of fire, flood, tempest, or another such cause, or as a result of governmental intervention, malicious damage, acts of war, strike, labor disputes, riot, or agency which the ToyCon has no control, or should the ToyCon decide that because of any such cause it is necessary to cancel, postpone, or re-site the show, or reduce installation time, exhibit time, or move out time, the ToyCon shall not be liable to indemnify or reimburse the Exhibitor in respect of any damage or loss, direct or indirect, arising as a result thereof.
